

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Skybridge (Aust) Pty Ltd recognizes that it has a primary responsibility to minimize the risk of harm or injury to any person from the conduct of its business, with the ultimate objective to eliminate any risk.

To achieve this, it is the responsibility of management, employees and contractors to eliminate hazards and develop safe work methods.

Management, employees and contractors shall at all times endeavour to complete all projects in a safe manner where people are not at risk due to an unsafe working environment.

Management (from the top down) will communicate the Skybridge health and safety policy to all employees, contractors and clients under our supervision and or control.

All workers will be inducted through the safety guidelines developed specifically for our workplaces.

In the management of its health and safety obligations Skybridge management will take the steps necessary to understand the intent of relevant health and safety legislation and associated statutory regulations and apply that intent to the provision of a safe workplace.

The promotion and maintenance for health and safety is the joint responsibility of management and employees, however, management at all levels is required to take responsibility, promote and contribute to the health and safety of all persons in the work place.

Management will do this by developing policies and procedures to protect all persons in the workplace.

Contractors are responsible for taking the necessary measures to ensure that the workplace under their control is safe and without risk to anyone's health and that the behaviour of all persons in the workplace is safe and without risk to health in keeping with the company policies and procedures.

They shall ensure all persons under their control are aware of company safety procedures and adhere to them at all times.

All contractors while undertaking to complete work for and on behalf of the company will abide by and respond to the company health and safety system. This will include participating in safety inductions, and observing all the company health and safety policies and procedures.

For safe behaviour in the workplace, all employees are required to comply and adhere to the company health and safety policies and procedures so as not to cause risk of health or injury to themselves or others.
